

16-19 tuition fund 2021-2022

In 2021-2022 we received £8397 in funding from the DfE, to support Sixth Form students this academic year. There was a carry forward of £945 from the 2020-2021 funding of £7545.

In line with DfE guidance, we used this funding to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in GCSE English and Maths. We focused our activity on students who had not yet achieved Grade 4 or 5 in English and/or Maths. The funding was used to support tuition above and beyond our core GCSE English and Maths resit offer.

We provided small group tuition for the 8 students studying GCSE English, and the 17 students studying GCSE Maths. Following an evaluation of the effectiveness of the third party provider used last year it has been decided to use them again. We decided to run face to face tuition as opposed to remote tuition due to screen fatigue.

The tuition was in groups of up to of 5 students and was focused for each student on areas identified as requiring intervention. Funding was used to cover the cost of the tutoring alone. We have used the internal assessment scripts from the summer exam series to identify areas of weakness to focus on. The total cost of this tuition was £8760 (£2160+£6600).

In addition to this we provided an excellent external motivational speaker, Alex Staniforth, to encourage resilience and a positive mind set, this was well received by the students. The cost of this was £339.60.
