| Are students allowed to attend school after June 5 <sup>th</sup> to receive support with their exam preparation? | We have provided students and parents/carers with a timetable of the external examinations as well as the timetable of exam preparation sessions. These take place throughout the entire exam period. Students are expected to attend school full time until the end of Friday 26th May. After this date, students are to attend school for either their external examinations or to attend a scheduled examination preparation session.   |

Parents/carers have been emailed with the arrangements for how the school will administer the exams where clashes occur. We will provide detailed guidance for students and support throughout these days.
