

School Performance Data

Sixth Form 2024

Helsby High School's Sixth Form students once again achieved excellent results, both at A-Level and in equivalent Level 3 qualifications. Nearly a third of all grades achieved were A*/A or equivalent, and well over half of all grades were at grade B or above. Students achieved well across all 30 of the A-Level and Vocational qualifications they studied, demonstrating the ongoing success of our state school Sixth Form.

Sixth Form attainment in 2024

- A-level average points score was 31.5 (C) compared to national average of 35.55 (B-)
- Academic qualifications (including A-levels) average point score was 31.33 (C) compared to national average of 35.69 (B-)
- Applied General average points score was 32.35 (Dist-) compared to national average of 29.17 (Merit+)

Sixth Form progress in 2024

- A-level progress was -0.22, meaning that students at Helsby High School achieved slightly below the national average progress compared to students of similar prior attainment.
- Applied General progress was +0.05, meaning that students at Helsby High School achieved slightly above the national average progress compared to students of similar prior attainment.

Student destinations KS5 (2022 Leavers)

- Students that left 16 to 18 study at this school or college in 2022 (the most recently available DfE data), who either stayed in education or went into employment from October to March the following year, was 89% compared to local authority average of 89% and England average of 80%.
- Students staying in education was 54% compared to local authority average of 62% and England average of 45%.
- Students entering apprenticeships was 7% compared to local authority average of 4% and England average of 7%.
- Students entering employment was 28% compared to local authority average of 23% and England average of 28%.
- Students not in education or employment for at least two terms after leaving was 6% compared to local authority average of 8% and England average of 15%.
- Destination unknown was 5% compared to local authority average of 3% and England average of 5%.
