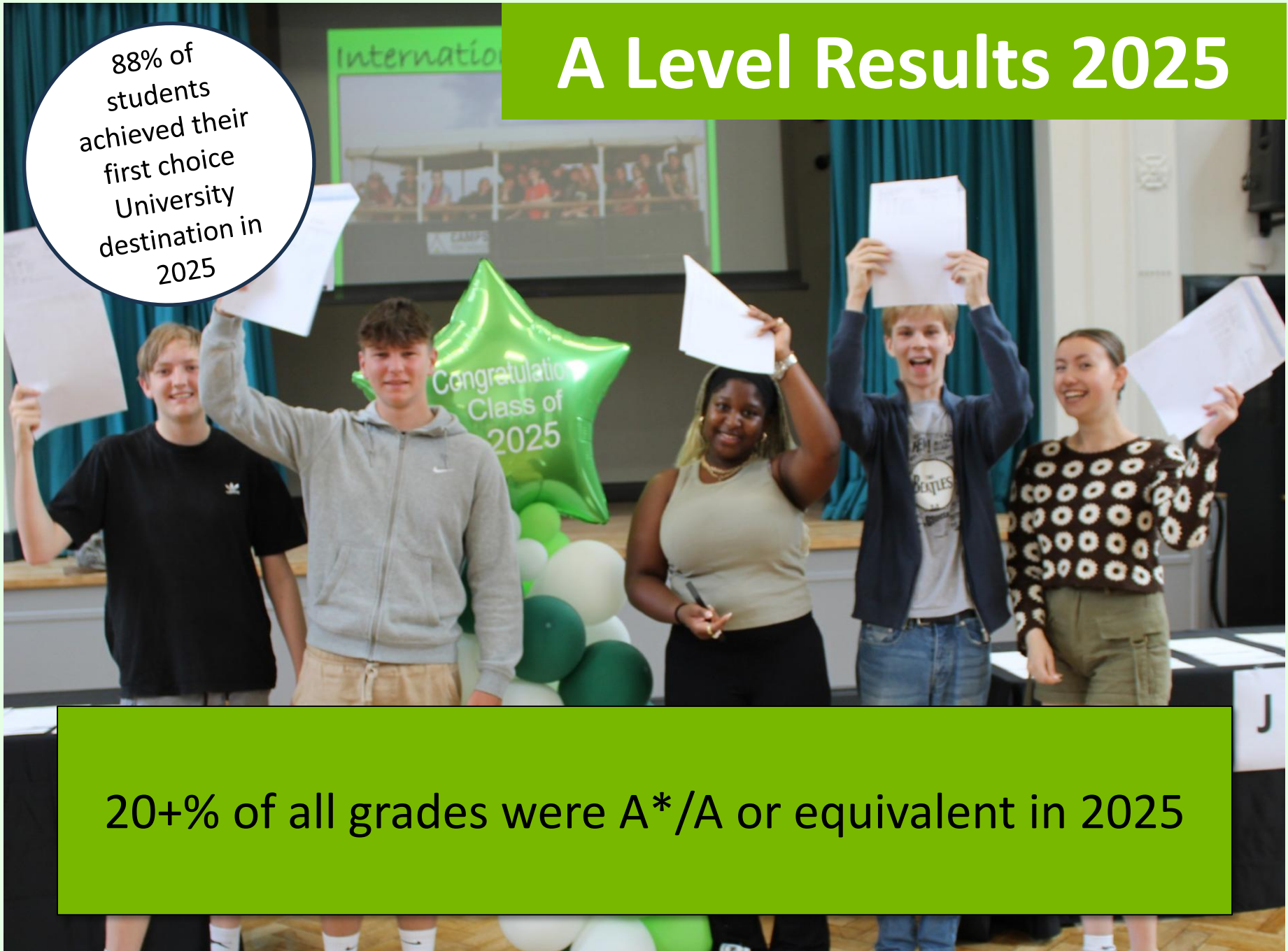

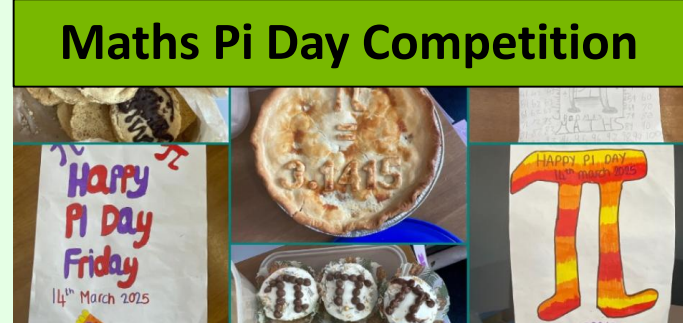

How do we help your child transition from Year 6 to Year 7?

- Year 7 Buddies visit Primary Schools from March onwards
- HHS Staff visit your child at Primary School (1-2 times)
- HHS Staff meet with your child's Year 6 teacher
- Induction Evening 30th June or 1st July 2026
- Induction Days 6th and 7th July 2026
- Additional transition day – 12th June 2026
- Additional transition support provided as required, which will include a Summer School on 18th-20th August 2026 for Year 6 students
